CLUBS AND AWARDS

Here's a complete list of the Clubs and Awards available to any agent and Agency in the Globe Life General Agency Division selling insurance for United American Insurance Company, Globe Life Insurance Company of New York, and Globe Life And Accident Insurance Company. These Clubs and Awards are designed for you so we can recognize and show our appreciation for your effort, energy, enthusiasm, and sales acumen. If you qualify to participate, you deserve to stand out from the crowd.

Annual Sales Convention

Each year, the Company rewards its top sales people and their spouse/guest with a prestigious trip to Convention.

Our Company has always invited the spouse and/or guest of the agent to Convention because of the sacrifices he or she makes when the agent is in the field. We always consider Convention qualifying as our top award.

Convention Qualifications for 2026

There are three ways to qualify for Convention 2026: Meeting production qualifications, issuing 100 or more Convention Apps as personal production, or issuing 50 or more Cancer Convention Apps as personal production or 150 Cancer Convention Apps as Agency production during the 2025 Convention qualification period, Dec 22, 2024 through Dec 27, 2025.

All production qualifications for Awards, Clubs, and the 2026 Convention, are based on Net Annualized Issued Premium (NAIP), which must be 70 percent or more of the Gross Annualized Premium (GAP).

A Convention App is Medicare Supplement Insurance, Cancer, Critical Illness, Final Expense (except in New York), and MMGAP. A Cancer Convention App is a UA Cash Cancer App.

Non-standard (Underage Disability) Medicare Supplement Insurance production, annuity production, and, in New York, life production do not count toward qualifications for Convention, Awards, or Club honors.

Rookie Definition

A rookie is an agent that has not completed one full fiscal year since issuing their first piece of commissionable business this decade. So, to be specific, any rookie agent from 2024 that issued their first piece of business on January 3, 2024 or later will still be a rookie in 2025 since they had less than 52 weeks of being a rookie in 2024. This is very different from the definition in 2022 and earlier wherein they were a rookie for the fiscal year they appointed and it did not matter what week they were appointed in.

Agents can only earn Convention as a rookie (\$75,000) once. Rookies do not qualify for the Highest Increase Award.



ANNUAL PRODUCTION AWARDS

Double Eagle Club

Any member of the Eagle Club who has an agent/Agency in their hierarchy that also qualifies as an Eagle is awarded the Double Eagle Club Award.

Eagle Club

Contracted Agents (any level) who produce more than \$1,000,000 or more in NAIP may qualify for the Eagle Club. Membership in this elite club is limited to the top ten (10) in Agency production by NAIP, not counting Double Eagles. All Eagles receive an award at Convention. First-time qualifiers also receive an Eagle Club ring. The ring is updated with an additional diamond each year the General Agent qualifies for the Eagle Club, up to 10 years. Eagle Club members are invited to a second meeting to communicate with senior management as an agent advisory board.

Eagle and Double Eagle Club Selection Process

We start with a list of all agencies with \$1M or more of NAIP. From that list of agencies, set aside agencies that have at least one downline agency on the list. (potential Double Eagles) From the remaining agencies, select the top 10 based on NAIP. Then we review the potential Double Eagle list to determine if they still have at least one downline agency on the top 10 list. If they do, they remain a Double Eagle. If they don't, then move them down to the Eagles top 10 list and remove the bottom agency on that list.

President's Club

Contracted agents (any level) who produce \$350,000 or more in NAIP during the qualification period may qualify for the President's Club. Membership in this exclusive club is limited to the top ten (10) producers not earning Eagle or Double Eagle status. President Club members receive an award at Convention.

Pacesetter's Club

Writing agents may qualify with their NAIP as a Pacesetter. Members of this production club are those ranking 1-30 who achieve the highest personal production NAIP during the qualification period. Writing agents who make the club will receive a plaque at Convention.

Rookie of the Year Award

The Rookie of the Year Award will be awarded at Convention to the top five (5) producing agents who qualify and attend Convention. To qualify, the agent must be contracted directly with the Company (any level) for the first time, produce a minimum \$75,000 NAIP qualifying personal production during the qualification period, and attend Convention.

Highest Increase Award

The top ten (10) agents/Agencies with the highest NAIP increase year-over-year will receive an award recognizing outstanding achievement.

Non-standard (Underage Disability) Medicare Supplement Insurance production and Annuity production will not count towards qualification for Convention, Awards, or Club honors.

Million Dollar Producer Club

Any agent that produces \$1M in NAIP during the qualification period will be awarded the golden Million Dollar Producer blazer/jacket at Convention.

Best of the Best Club

You can qualify for this club in 3 ways.

- 1. Issue \$250K NAIP as a Writing Agent.
- 2. Issue \$1M NAIP as an Agency.
- 3. Earn Convention as a Double Qualifier (Writing Agent and Agency).

Attendees come to this event without their plus-ones, and we divide our time between business and fun.

Non-standard (Underage Disability) Medicare Supplement Insurance production, annuity production, and, in New York, life production do not count toward qualifications for Convention, Awards, or Club honors. Contracted Agents (any level) must have 70% persistency, and an agent's quality of business must align with the company's standards to qualify for awards.
